



# How to Safely Reuse Trigger Sprayer Heads

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic there has been an increase in cleaning and disinfecting, causing a shortage in supply for sprayer heads. These trigger sprayer heads can be safely reused if properly cleaned.

## Step 1.

Before you begin please wear personal protection equipment (PPE). We recommend wearing glasses or goggles and gloves.

## Step 2.

In a sink, remove the sprayer head from the bottle with the tube attached. Rinse thoroughly under warm water.

## Step 3.

Next, fill a bucket or container with warm water. Immerse the sprayer tube into the water.

## Step 4.

Point the trigger sprayer head into the sink, keeping the tube in the water and squeeze the trigger about 15-20 times. This will flush the tube and nozzle. Continue this process until the warm water sprays easily and there is no discoloration in the water.

## Step 5.

In the event that the sprayer head is being used between two incompatible products, we recommend flushing the sprayer head with warm water for no less than two minutes to remove all excess residue. Be sure the water runs clear without any discoloration.



**\*Bleach products, containing sodium or potassium hypochlorite, are not compatible with any other product.**
