

How To Properly Clean & Disinfect Plexiglass

With A2Z Disinfecting Glass Cleaner, the solution is in your hands.



Longevity, clarity, and most importantly, health are the reasons why a proper cleaning routine is key for your plexiglass.

- Before you begin, clear the area of any debris or objects that may obstruct the cleaning process.
- First, visibly soiled surfaces must be cleaned prior to disinfecting.
- TO CLEAN: To avoid damaging the panel, use a clean microfiber cloth. Using A2Z as a cleaner, wet the cloth and apply it to the glass. Lightly blot the surface, being careful not to apply too much pressure.
- Using the dry side of the cloth, buff the same area to pick up any remaining suds or water. This can prevent future stains, leaving more time in between cleaning.
- Let air dry. If any marks or smudges remain, repeat the process.
- TO DISINFECT: Spray your A2Z disinfectant on the plexiglass. Following the dwell time specified on the label, allow the product to sit. After the proper amount of time has gone by, use a clean microfiber cloth to wipe down the plexiglass. Use the same buffing motion that you would for cleaning.
 *NOT FOR USE ON FOOD CONTACT SURFACES
 - Do not use paper towels, they will not remove scratches and may even cause them
 - Inspect the glass for scratches, cracks, and other issues that may cause problems when doing this procedure.
